ENTRY AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I agree to abide by the rules of this competition as set forth by the management of this show. I understand that the show management has the right to modify, change cancel, combine classes and class specifications, over rule, and /or make judgments over any discrepancies or issues that may arise during the competition. I agree to allow show management the use of my photos taken at this competition to be used in results articles, promotional flyers, and etc.

Under Massachusetts Law, Section 2D of Chapter 128 of the General Laws, "no participant or participant's representative shall make any claim against, maintain as action against, or recover from an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the inherent risks of equine activities.

I understand that EQUINE ACTIVITIES are potentially dangerous, and that I may be injured and/or lose or damage personal property as a result of participation in the program, lesson and/or competition. Therefore, I ASSUME ALL RISKS RELATED TO THE ACTIVITIES including but not limited to: bodily injury of any nature whether severe or not, including but not limited to head trauma, joint trauma, broken bones, oral, eye or other facial injury, other muscular-skeletal injury which may be temporary or permanent, including death, which may occur as a result of riding horses, contact with horses or equipment, physical surroundings or other riders and horses. I understand that injuries such as fractures, joint/muscle sprains and dislocations, and contusions are commonplace in sports.

Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with owner, leasee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider and the horse (1) shall be subject to the constitution and local rules of the show;(2) that every horse, rider, and or driver is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the constitution and rules of the show and will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, FFJJC, their officials, directors, and employees and volunteers harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in conjunction with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show.

- Un-judged warm up 18"-2'3" starts at 8 AM, Classes will start at 9AM (second warm up will be held after 2'3" classes conclude for 2'6" and higher)
- Classes offered from ground poles through 3'3"
- \$15 per class if entry received before day of show; \$20 per class if entering day of the show (Ground pole classes always \$15)
- Un-judged warm up is \$10 per horse, trainers allowed in ring
- Show management reserves the right to divide classes
- Negative 12-Month Coggins & rabies required for all equines on the property
- Ribbons pinned 1st-6th
- 3 classes at each level: A) First round clean, timed jump off B) One round against the clock and C) Power and Speed
- Riders can mix and match classes; you do not need to enter all three classes at each height
